Klorman Construction Tapped as General Contractor for Gold Line Extension Parking Structure

AZUSA, CA. – December 8, 2014 -- Klorman Construction has been selected as the general contractor by the Foothill Transit Authority to build a 547-car parking structure in Azusa, Cal.

Woodland Hills, Ca.-based Klorman Construction will manage the overall construction process of the 4-level concrete parking structure at the Azusa Intermodal Parking Facility, which is located at 801 N. Alameda Ave. in Azusa, CA.

This project is the second parking structure for Foothill Transit and the fifth major public transit development undertaken by Klorman Construction in the last several years. The company had previously been chosen to Design-Build a 261-car parking structure for L.A. Metropolitan Transit Authority in East Los Angeles as well as to construct the 7-story structural concrete portion of the new Tom Bradley International Terminal at Los Angeles International Airport (LAX).

This most recent project will serve patrons of the future Gold Line Foothill Extension Azusa-Alameda Station.

The Gold Line Foothill Extension is an under construction 23.9 mile extension of the Metro Gold Line light rail corridor from its current terminus in Pasadena east through the "Foothill Cities" of Los Angeles County into San Bernardino County.

The Klorman Construction portion of the project requires extensive demo and relocation of existing utilities and includes the expansion of an adjacent street lane to accommodate four bus bays for loading and unloading passengers.
