Klorman Construction Selected to Build 562-car Higuera Parking Structure in Culver City

Woodland Hills, Ca. – Nov. 19, 2013 --- Hackman Capitol has selected Klorman Construction as the design/build contractor for a five-level post-tensioned concrete parking structure in Culver City.

The Higuera Parking Structure will include 562 stalls and will be noteworthy for its deep, cast-in-drilled piles, which will be necessary to strengthen and stabilize the structure given its location adjacent to Ballona Creek. The unique construction model is necessary given the soft soil conditions next to Ballona Creek.

“This project presents certain challenges given the soil conditions in the area and the unusual shape with large cantilevered angular slabs,” said Bill Klorman, president of Klorman Construction. “But we’ve come across such situations in the past, and our well-developed systems can easily overcome these and any other difficulties projects may pose.”
