# Klorman Construction Completes Concrete Work for Passenger Boarding Bridges at LAX's Terminal 2

Klorman Construction recently installed cast in place pile foundation for the new Passenger Boarding Bridges system in Terminal 2 at LAX, part of a major overhaul and renovation program of Terminal 2 designed to significantly improve the level of service and appearance of the 30-year-old building.
